You'll meet your local guide in the lobby of the Historic Davenport Hotel at 10:20AM, then begin your tour...Walk through the former Expo' 74 site – now Riverfront Park – and start with a Sculpture Walk through the park to see a wide variety of unique art by local artists. Next, take a ride on the 1909 Loeffl Carrousel, named one of the "Top Ten in the United States." Young or old, this is a Spokane experience you can't miss!

Next, as you walk through downtown, your guide will tell you about the Great Fire of 1889 that leveled downtown. See what rose from the rubble and how the historic buildings have been repurposed for today.

Stop at Terra Blanca Winery, located in the historic Chronicle Building; their wines come from the famed Red Mountain AVA Region in SE Washington and they offer acclaimed reds, whites and dessert wines. Enjoy hors d'oeuvres with your wine. At the Nectar Tasting Room, the owner searches Washington State for the best wines to share with Spokane each month. Here we'll enjoy charcuterie plates to complement the wines.

Along the way, listen to some interesting and colorful stories about Spokane in the late 1800's, when it was a wild town catering to the miners from Idaho's Silver Valley.

Last stop is the gondola Skyride over the Spokane Falls!
